Resurrection is inviting people to participate in the ELCIC's Reformation Challenge, celebrating the 500th Anniversary of the Reformation.

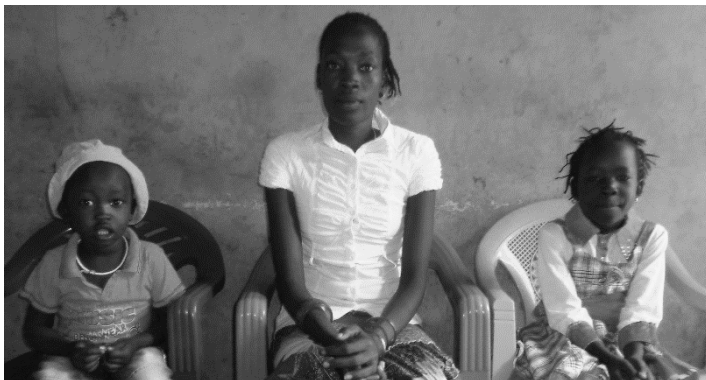
One challenge is (for Lutheran congregations) to sponsor 500 new refugees. Resurrection, Halifax, is in the process of bringing 12 Ethiopians via Nairobi, through Canada Lutheran World Relief. The 12 will be reunited with their sister (a member at Resurrection) and her family who came a number of years ago as refugees.

Currently the family lives in a tiny room in Nairobi. As Ethiopians they are not allowed to work, children cannot go to school, and medical services are expensive.

They will be arriving before September 2017. It is the sponsor's responsibility to support the family for an entire year and help them to acclimatize to Canadian culture. You are invited to be a part of this project! Below is a wish book. Items are "gifts" that will support the family. Gifts are being collected as monetary donations. All donations will be used to support this family (any additional funds will be used for future refugee projects).

Backpack of school supplies - \$60 (x6)
Children's snow pants/coats - \$50 (x7)
Bedding + pillows - \$800
Towels - \$385

Rent - 3 bedroom apt. \$1400 (x2)
Cell Phone - \$40 (x4 - one for each adult who will be working)
Bus pass - \$78 (x5 - one for each adult)
A week of groceries - \$400
